The Parador:

Nestling snugly in the Val d'Arán among the wooded slopes of the Catalan Pyrenees, this modern Parador, built in the traditional local style, offers the visitor the perfect mountain holiday. In summer you may enjoy the sun and the outdoor swimming pool, while in winter the hotel provides a cosy refuge after a day on the nearby ski slopes – currently undergoing a major expansion. Situated 7 km from the ancient town of Vielha and the classy ski resort of Baqueira, the Parador is in the little village of Arties, and built on the site of the house of Don Gaspar de Portolà, the 18th-century soldier and governor of California who founded both San Diego and Monterey.

The Parador is located at the gates of the town of Arties, 7 km from Vielha. It can be reached using the roadway C-28 and the camping Era Yerla as a focus point. The Parador being located in a rather mountainous area, we would suggest equipping your car with the appropriate tires during the winter season.
