

Parador de Avila



The Parador:

Located in the centre of the historic city of Avila in the heart of Castile, this Parador was once the Piedras Albas palace. The Parador backs onto the impressive city walls (including 88 towers), which, along with the cathedral and churches, has earned Avila its UNESCO World Heritage Site status. The Parador itself has its own fine, castellated tower, a garden, and a magnificent glazed patio, while the interior spaces have an atmosphere of period elegance.

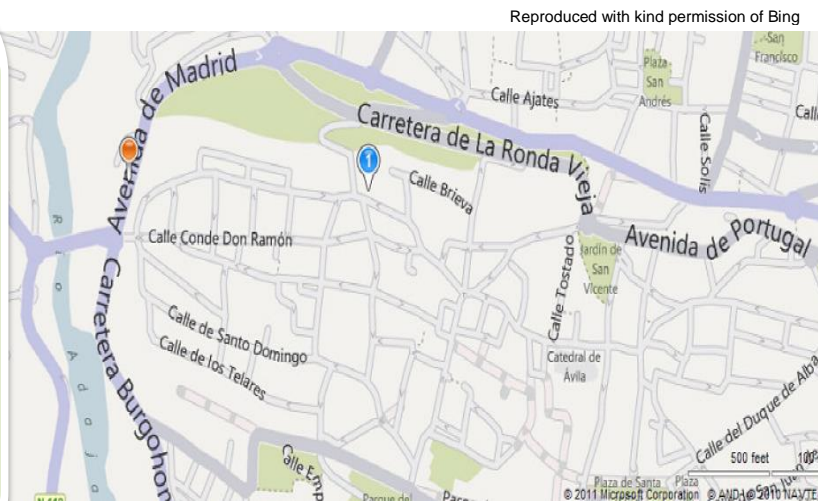
Arriving by car:

The Parador is located on Calle Marqués de Canales de Chozas, in the historical centre of the city, opposite Plaza de Concepción Arenal. It is reached by entering the city walls through the gate 'Puerta del Carmen'. Ávila is 115 km from Madrid.

Arriving by train:

You can reach the Parador de Avila from the train station on foot; a walk which will take approximately 25 minutes. Take Paseo de la Estación, then on to Calle de Eduardo Marquina. Walk through the little park to reach Calle del Duradero and Calle Marqués de Benavites. The Parador will be straight ahead.
