

Parador de Cervera de Pisuerga



The Parador:

Just outside the small town of Cervera de Pisuerga and with magnificent views down to the waters of the Ruesga reservoir, this traditionally built Parador is situated in the Fuentes Carrionas Nature Reserve in the foothills of the Picos de Europa, between Santander and León. The interior as well as the exterior reflects the theme of a hunting lodge, with impressive stone fireplaces, wood panelling, and walls decorated with the heads of wild animals. The comfort and cosiness of the public sitting areas are reflected in the bedrooms.



Arriving by car:

The Parador de Cervera de Pisuerga is located 2 km from the town centre of Cervera de Pisuerga on the foothills on the Picos de Europa, to the north of Palencia, next to the Ruesga reservoir. The main N-625 and N-611 roads to the east and west and the local 627 and 626 roads lead you to the Parador. Cervera is located 116 km from Palencia, the capital of the province.
