

Parador de Chinchon



The Parador:

This quiet former convent, with its charming cloisters and gardens, is situated in the old quarter of Chinchón, a small town 50 km southeast of Madrid. The Parador is close to the magnificent Plaza Mayor, which on summer Saturdays became the venue for bullfights, viewed by spectators from the surrounding balconies. Visitors to this atmospheric and beautifully restored historic building will be thankful that monasticism in the 17th century was not such an austere affair – in those days the monks and nuns enjoyed comfortable living and good eating, and these are qualities that may still be enjoyed by guests.

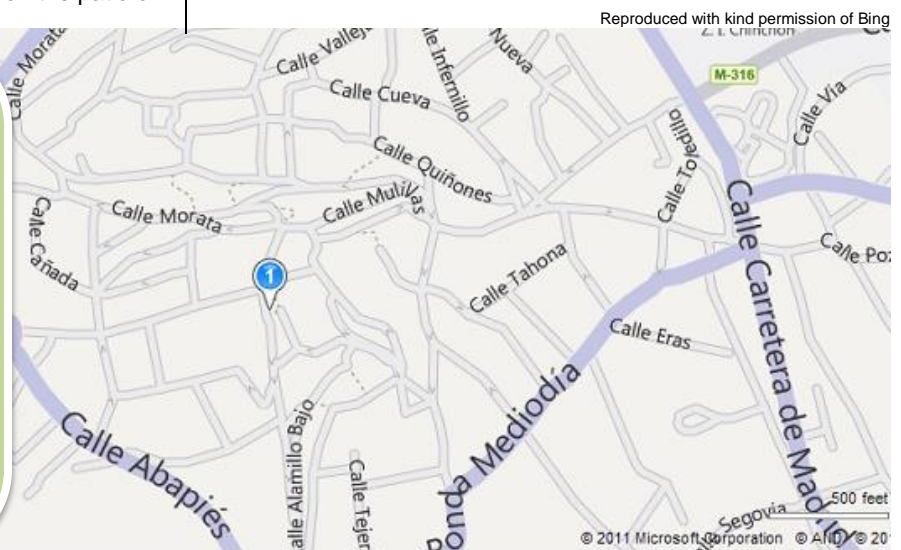

Chinchón is 60 km from Madrid along the N-IV, at the junction with the main 404 road, through Ciempozuelos. Another option is the A-3 dual carriageway, near the Puente de Arganda, linking up with the M-311 road.
