

## Parador de Cordoba



### The Parador:

The Parador La Arruzafa is situated 3 km above the city of Córdoba, on the site of the small summer palace built here in AD 765 by the Caliph Abdu'r-Raman, at the beginning of the golden age of the Moorish Caliphate of Córdoba. Abdu'r-Raman is said to have planted here the first palm trees in Europe, and arruzafa – the name of the Parador – means 'garden of the palm trees'. Abdu'r-Raman chose this hilly site well, for the temperature here in summer is on average 4 degrees centigrade cooler than in the city of Córdoba itself, and this makes the Parador La Arruzafa – with its shady gardens, outdoor pool and panoramic views over this legendary city – a comfortable and luxurious base for exploring this part of Andalusia, especially in the hot summer months.

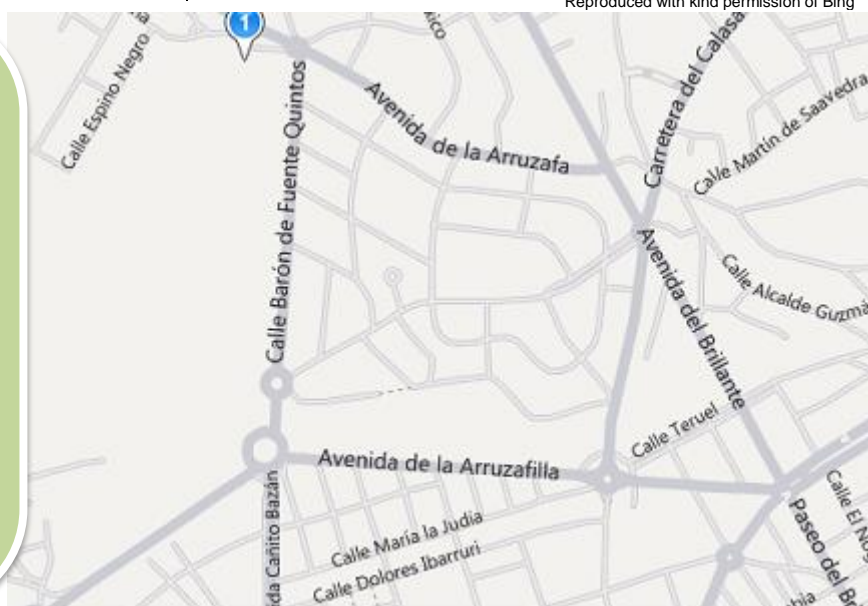
#### Arriving by car:

The Parador is located in the foothills of the Córdoba mountains in the residential district of Brillante. It is reached by taking the Córdoba Norte-Ctra. Badajoz turn off and then the Cordoba Norte entrance access. You then follow the Avenidas Agrupación Córdoba and Ollerías to the Paseo del Brillante, which becomes the Avenida del Brillante. You go up some 2km towards Avenida de la Arruzafa, and at 500 metres we find the Parador.

#### Arriving by train:

A 10min taxi drive (without traffic) will take you from the train station to the Parador. Alternatively, the journey on foot lasts 40min.

**Nearest airport:** Sevilla Airport (125km)



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
