

Parador de Santiago de Compostela



The Parador:

Built in 1499 by order of Ferdinand and Isabella to house visitors to Europe's most famous pilgrimage city, the Hostal dos Reis Católicos, as this magnificent five-star Parador is known, is considered to be the oldest hotel in the world. Today, it is also considered to be the jewel in the crown of the network of Paradors, and one of the most stunningly situated – it overlooks the Plaza do Obradoiro, and is next to the famous Romanesque cathedral with its Baroque façade, in the heart of the old town (a UNESCO World Heritage Site).

Arriving by car:

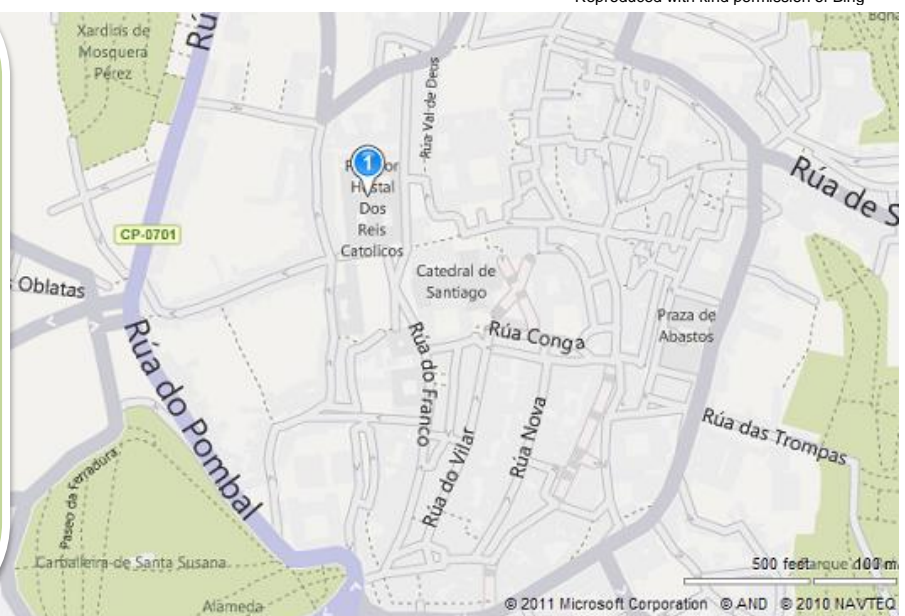
The Parador is located in Santiago's old quarter in the Plaza do Obradoiro, where some of the most outstanding monuments of the city can also be found: the cathedral, the town hall and the Colegio de San Xerome. From A Coruña you will reach Santiago along the main N-550 road, passing through Ordes, or along the A-9 motorway towards Pontevedra (65 km). Both roads take you to Noia, 34 km from Santiago, to Padrón, 22 km away and to Pontevedra, 59 km away.

Arriving by train:

The Parador de Santiago de Compostela is situated only a 15min walk away from the train station. You can reach the Parador by going through Rúa da Senra and Rúa do Franco.

Nearest airport: Santiago Airport (10km)
