

Parador de Santillana Gil Blas



The Parador:

This beautiful old stone building, built in the 17th and 18th centuries, was the ancestral home of the Barreda-Bracho family, and is located in the main square of one of the most attractive and well-preserved old villages in Spain, Santillana del Mar – a place known as ‘the town of three lies’, since it does not have a saint (santo) nor is it flat (llana), and nor is it by the sea (mar). The Parador has a pantiled roof, wrought-iron balconies, beamed ceilings, a garden and a sauna.

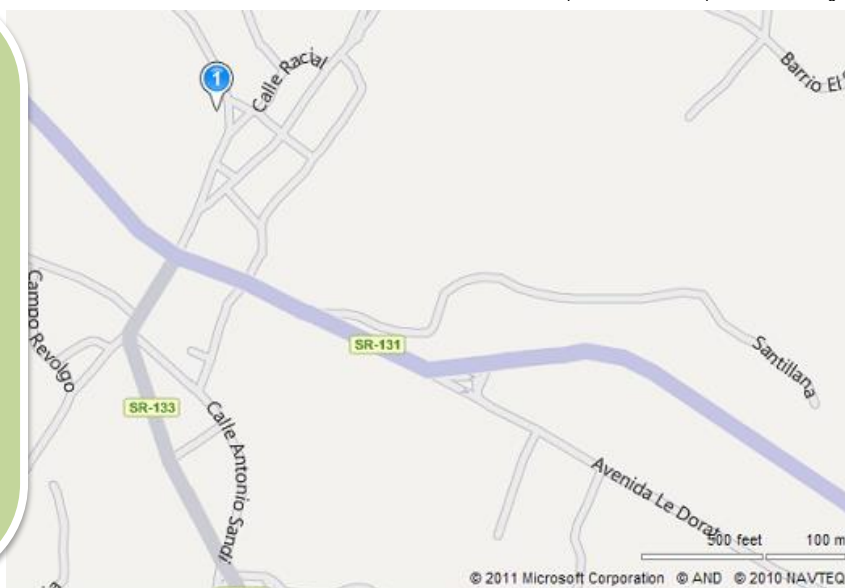
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Directions

Arriving by car:

The Parador is located in Santillana del Mar's main plaza, in which the city's most characteristic buildings are also located: Torre de Don Borja, Casa del Águila y la Parra, Torre de Merino and the Town Hall. You can reach the Parador by taking a right turn off Avenida de Dorat onto Plaza Gándara. Turn left onto Calle de la Carrera. Turn Right to stay on Calle De La Carrera. Turn left to stay on Calle De la Carrera. Turn right into Plaza Mayor and you have arrived. Santillana is located 24 km from Santander.

Nearest airport: Bilbao Airport (120km)



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
