

Parador de Soria



The Parador:

The town of Soria, situated on the River Duero between Zaragoza and Valladolid, has a number of historic buildings, including the town walls, Romanesque churches and a Baroque cathedral. To the north of the town lie the remains of Numantia, one of the last Celtic strongholds in Spain to fall to the Romans. The modern Parador de Soria, built on a hill, has splendid views over the town and the river. It was extensively renovated in 2004–5, and now incorporates a section of medieval wall as well.

- Cañón del Río Lobos Park (60km)

Directions

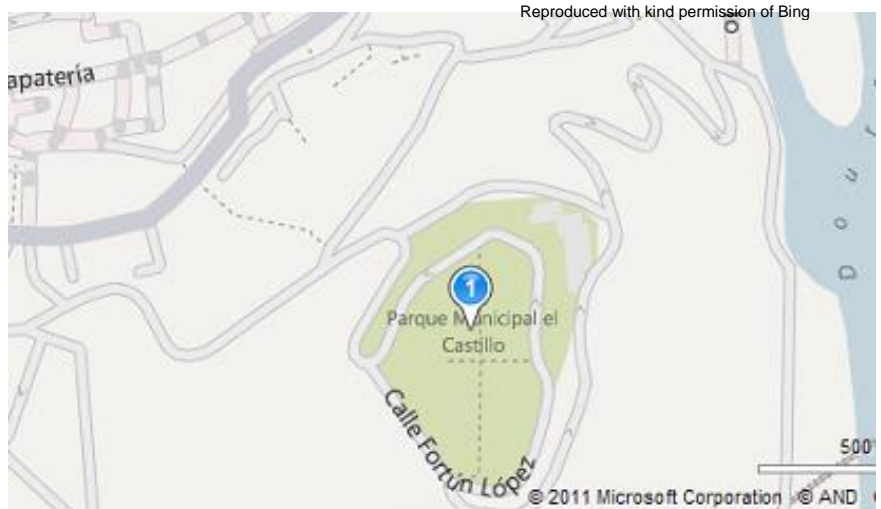
Arriving by car:
