

Parador de Sos del Rey Catolico



The Parador:

The Parador de Sos del Rey Católico, with its garden, stone walls and wooden balconies, fits in well with this small medieval town in Navarre, to the southeast of Pamplona. Among the historic buildings of Sos, declared a Historical-Artistic Area, are a number of old churches and the Sada Palace, the birthplace of Ferdinand of Aragón – hence the name of the town. There are views across the foothills towards the Pyrenees, and the nearby Yesa reservoir is a popular place for sailing and swimming.

- With such great views of the mountains and the old streets of the town beneath, it is well worth considering upgrading (for only a modest supplement) to a superior room at this Parador. The superior rooms on the 3rd floor have terraces, and superior 'plus' rooms on the 2nd floor have enclosed galleries giving you more space with similar views.

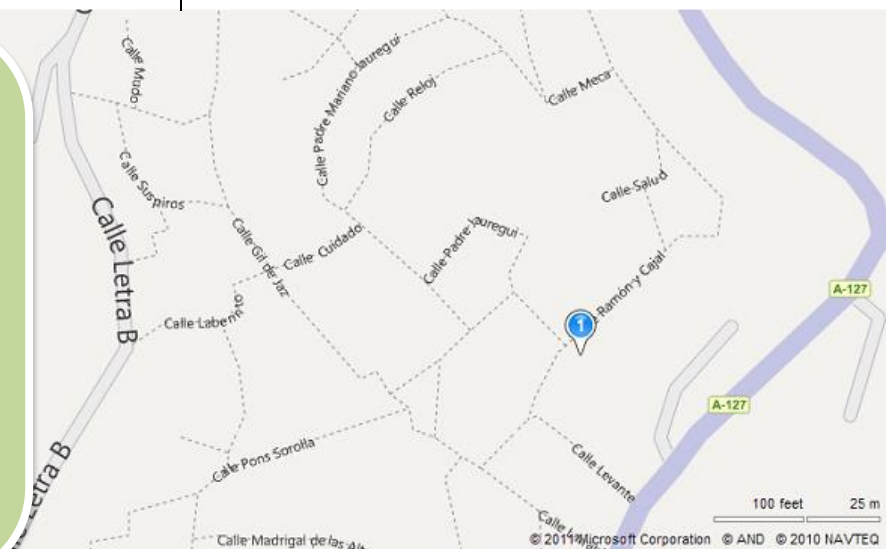

Arriving by car:

To the north of the Cinco Villas region, 122 km from Zaragoza and 58 km from Pamplona /Iruña, the Parador de Sos del Rey Católico is located at the end of the medieval wall, rising up above the town. The main A-127 road is the normal access route.
