

Parador de Teruel



The Parador:

The design of this grand Parador is inspired by the Mudéjar style, a medieval vernacular style derived from Moorish architecture. The Parador is on the outskirts of the city of Teruel, which is located in the mountains far to the northwest of Valencia. The city boasts a number of historic churches in the Mudéjar style, which prompted UNESCO to nominate it as a World Heritage Site. Teruel was the site of one of the bloodiest battles of the Spanish Civil War, during the course of which it changed hands several times.

Directions

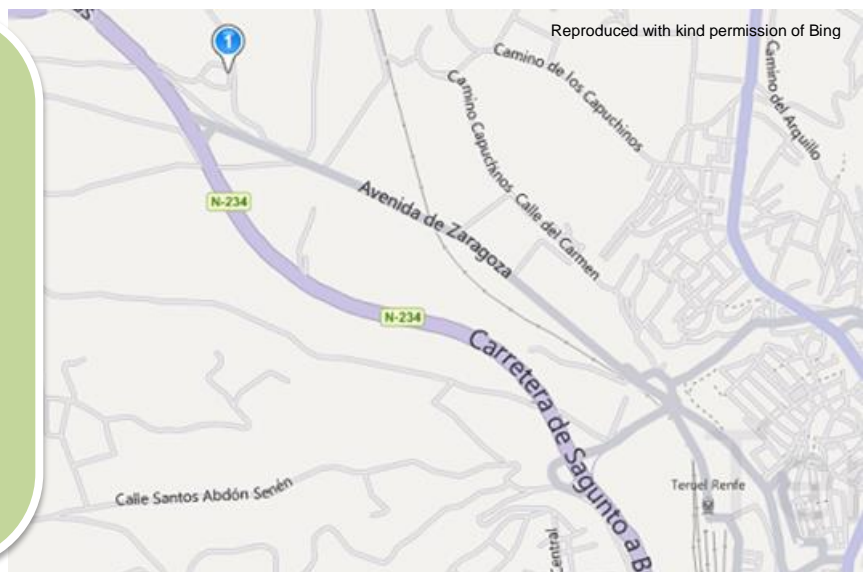
Arriving by car:

Some 2 km from the centre of the city, from the splendid Mudéjar towers and the Cathedral, it is 35 km from Albarracín, 40 km from Mora de Rubielos and 162 km from Alcañiz. The Parador is located next to the N-234 Sagunto-Burgos road, at kilometre 124.

Arriving by train:

The Parador de Teruel is only a 5 minutes' drive away from the train station without traffic, via Av. Zaragoza. Walking along the same street will take you around 30 minutes.

Nearest airport: Valencia Airport (160km)



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
